Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

In the first reading, the prophet Jeremiah speaks of a new covenant the Lord will establish with his people. And why was the Lord establishing a new covenant, we might ask: What happened to the old one? As Jeremiah describes and as we see throughout the Old Testament, the recurring problem was disobedience. The Israelites failed, time and again, to obey the Lord's commandments, rebelling against the Lord, choosing instead to follow the ways of their neighbors, or to live as they chose. But obedience is a difficult pill for us to swallow, especially when that obedience involves accepting suffering. No one wants to suffer. No one wants to see their loved ones suffer. But none of us will leave this earth without experiencing suffering. But this suffering doesn't have to be pointless or meaningless. God has the power to use it for his purpose, to bring about goodness and life through it as he did with Christ's suffering. What he asks of us is that we remain obedient, that we not rebel and turn away from him. And to help us do so, Christ nourishes us with his own body and blood, with his very self, that we might grow in his likeness, grow in obedience to God, and remain with him forever.

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

En la primera lectura, el profeta Jeremías habla de una nueva alianza, que el Señor establecerá con su pueblo. ¿Y por qué el Señor estaba estableciendo un nuevo pacto, podríamos preguntarnos: ¿Qué pasó con el antiguo? Como Jeremías describe y como vemos a lo largo del Antiguo Testamento, El problema recurrente de la desobediencia. Los israelitas fracasaron, una y otra vez, para obedecer los mandamientos del Señor, rebelándose contra el Señor, elegir en cambio seguir los caminos de sus vecinos o vivir como ellos. Pero la obediencia es una píldora difícil de tragar para nosotros, especialmente cuando la obediencia implica aceptar el sufrimiento. Nadie quiere sufrir. Nadie quiere ver sufrir a sus seres queridos. Pero ninguno de nosotros dejará esta tierra sin experimentar sufrimiento. Pero este sufrimiento no tiene por qué ser inútil o sin sentido. Dios tiene el poder de usarlo para su propósito, para generar bondad y vida. a través de él como lo hizo con el sufrimiento de Cristo. Lo que nos pide es que permanezcamos obedientes, para que no nos rebelemos y nos alejemos de él. Y para ayudarnos a ello, Cristo nos nutre con su propio cuerpo y sangre, para que podamos crecer a su semejanza, crecer en obediencia a Dios, y permanecer con él para siempre.
