Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

Each year on Holy Thursday, Pope Francis has opted to wash feet not necessarily within the confines of Saint Peter's Basilica, but in prisons, care facilities, or refugee centers. It is here, at the "peripheries," where Pope Francis follows Jesus' lead. While we commonly see the miracle of this story as Jesus healing leprosy, just as extraordinary is the man's willingness to approach Jesus, to risk even more censure, punishment, or even his life, to receive the love and healing touch of the Lord. This was possible, of course, because Jesus made himself available. As we return to the sacrament to come, we remember Pope Francis' teaching that the Eucharist does not end with our reception of holy Communion. The Eucharist must be brought outside the doors of the church through our very lives-the body of Christ in action. If we are going to embody Jesus in our world today, we must go where he went, to the peripheries.

First Reading: "As long as the sore is on him, he shall declare him-self unclean, since he is in fact unclean. He shall dwell apart, making his abode outside the camp." (Lv 13,8)

Psalms: I turn to you, Lord, in time of trouble, and you fill me with the joy of salvation. (Ps 32)

Second Reading: Whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God. (1Cor 10,31)

Gospel: Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. (Mk 1,41-42)

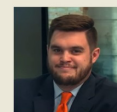

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

Cada año, el Jueves Santo, el Papa Francisco ha optado por lavar los pies, no necesariamente dentro de los límites de la Basílica de San Pedro, sino en las cárceles, centros de atención o centros de refugiados. Es aquí, en las “periferias”, donde El Papa Francisco sigue el ejemplo de Jesús. Si bien comúnmente vemos el milagro de esta historia como la curación de Jesús lepra, igualmente extraordinaria es la disposición del hombre a acercarse a Jesús, arriesgar aún más censura, castigo o incluso su vida, para recibir la amor y toque sanador del Señor. Esto era posible, por supuesto, porque Jesús se puso a disposición. Al regresar al sacramento venidero, recordamos el mensaje del Papa Francisco. enseñando que el Eucristo no termina con nuestra recepción de la santa Comunión. La Eucaristía debe ser llevada fuera de las puertas de la iglesia a través de nuestras vidas: el cuerpo de Cristo en acción. Si nosotros estamos Para encarnar a Jesús en nuestro mundo de hoy, debemos ir adonde Él fue, para las periferias.
