Dear Parishioners:

We all know we should listen to Christ. We have all been told we should do as God commands. There is a prayer that begins: "Father, I abandon myself into your hands. Do with me what you will..." While most of us would affirm this sentiment on some level, if we take a moment to really sit with the idea of abandoning ourselves into God's hands, of letting go of what we want and asking God to do what only he wills... well, some of us might begin to squirm. Our God did not hold back anything, not even his beloved Son, to lead us to the good ness he desires for us. In the Transfiguration, he shows us the glory that awaits us when we live and love in service of him. And this God is present here today. In this sacred season, God is inviting us to listen more closely to his beloved Son who invites us to take and eat, to receive the gift of Jesus Christ, poured out for us in this Eucharist.
