Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

Saint Peter begins his address by telling his listeners: You know what has happened all over Judea. We, too, know the story of Jesus being raised from the dead. And because we have heard it many times, we may be somewhat unmoved by what we are here to celebrate. A man who was put to death by hanging him on a tree was raised on the third day. The disciples ate and drank with a man who rose from the dead.

This is truly amazing: here it might be helpful to step back to the part of the story we hear in John's Gospel wherein Mary of Magdala, Peter, and the beloved disciple encounter the empty tomb.

Today we celebrate in a particular way that the risen Christ is truly present. Not even death could keep him from us. So mighty is his love that he transformed the evil of the cross into a blessing through which he can eternally unite us to God. He is here. He is risen! Alleluia!



Scripture Readings

First Reading: This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. (Acts 10,40-41)

Psalm: This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad. (Ps 118)

Second Reading: If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. (Col 3,1)

Gospel: For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead. (Jn 20,9)

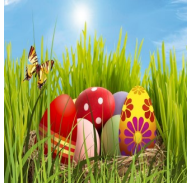

Estimados feligreses:

San Pedro comienza su discurso diciendo a sus oyentes: Vosotros sabéis lo que ha sucedido en toda Judea. Nosotros también conocemos la historia de la resurrección de Jesús. de entre los muertos. Y como lo hemos escuchado muchas veces, es posible que estemos algo impasibles ante lo que estamos aquí para celebrar.

Hoy celebramos de manera particular que Cristo resucitado es verdaderamente presente. Ni siquiera la muerte pudo alejarlo de nosotros. Tan poderoso es su amor que transformó el mal de la cruz en bendición mediante la cual puede unirnos eternamente a Dios. Él está aquí. ¡Él ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya!
