Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

In today's Gospel, Jesus takes the Pharisees and scribes to task for being hypocrites: "honoring God with their lips" while having: "hearts that are far from him." In direct opposition to the instructions given to the Israelites by Moses all those many years ago prior to being allowed to enter the Promised Land, they have added to the statutes and decrees of the Lord. They disregard God's commandment but cling to human tradition and teach human precepts as doctrines. They have been imposing too many rules on people which they do not necessarily follow, making observance of the law more burdensome. The Lord knows us. He loves us. He wants us to do better, to be better. He wants us to be in communion with him, here and for eternity. So, when we struggle, the Lord is there to help us, especially through the sacraments. Going to confession can be difficult, but in this sacrament, Christ not only frees us from the burden of our sins, but also strengthens us to resist temptation. And in the eucharist, the great sacrament we are gathered to celebrate, we receive that help and encourage everyone we know to do so as well.

Scripture Readings

First Reading: Moses said to the people: "Now, Israel, hear the statutes and decrees which I am teaching you to observe, that you may live, and may enter in and take possession of the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, is giving you. In your observance of the commandments of the LORD, your God, which I enjoin upon you, you shall not add to what I command you nor subtract from it. Observe them carefully, for thus will you give evidence of your wisdom and intelligence to the nations, who will hear of all these statutes and say, 'This great nation is truly a wise and intelligent people.' For what great nation is there that has gods so close to it as the LORD, our God, is to us whenever we call upon him? Or what great nation has statutes and decrees that are as just as this whole law which I am setting before you today?" (Dt 4:1-2, 6-8)

Psalm: The one who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord. Ps 15:2-3, 3-4, 4-5)

Second Reading: Dearest brothers and sisters: All good giving and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no alteration or shadow caused by change. He willed to give us birth by the word of truth that we may be a kind of first fruits of his creatures. Humbly welcome the word that has been planted in you and is able to save your souls. Be doers of the word and not hearers only, deluding yourselves. Religion that is pure and undefiled before God and the Father is this: to care for orphans and widows in their affliction and to keep oneself unstained by the world. (Jas 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27)

Gospel: " When the Pharisees with some scribes who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus, they observed that some of his disciples ate their meals with unclean, that is, unwashed, hands. —For the Pharisees and, in fact, all Jews, do not eat without carefully washing their hands, keeping the tradition of the elders. And on coming from the marketplace they do not eat without purifying themselves. And there are many other things that they have traditionally observed, the purification of cups and jugs and kettles and beds. — So the Pharisees and scribes questioned him, "Why do your disciples not follow the tradition of the elders but instead eat a meal with unclean hands?" He responded, "Well did Isaiah prophesy about you hypocrites, as it is written: *This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts.* You disregard God's commandment but cling to human tradition....." (Mk 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23)



Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús reprende a los fariseos y escribas por ser hipócritas: "honran a Dios con sus labios" mientras que tienen "corazones que están lejos de él". En oposición directa a las instrucciones dadas a los israelitas por Moisés hace muchos años antes de que se les permitiera entrar en la Tierra Prometida, han añadido a los estatutos y decretos del Señor. Ignoran el mandamiento de Dios, pero se aferran a la tradición humana y enseñan preceptos humanos como doctrinas. Han estado imponiendo demasiadas reglas a las personas que no necesariamente siguen, haciendo que la observancia de la ley sea más pesada. El Señor nos conoce. Nos ama. Quiere que lo hagamos mejor, que seamos mejores. Quiere que estemos en comunión con él, aquí y por la eternidad. Entonces, cuando luchamos, el Señor está allí para ayudarnos, especialmente a través de los sacramentos. Ir a la confesión puede ser difícil, pero en este sacramento, Cristo no solo nos libera de la carga de nuestros pecados, sino que también nos fortalece para resistir la tentación. Y en la Eucaristía, el gran sacramento que nos reunimos para celebrar, recibimos esa ayuda y animamos a todos los que conocemos a hacer lo mismo.
