Dear Parishioners:

In a multitude of different ways, Scripture tells us to place our hope in the Lord. For Isaiah, hope could be found in the restored Israel. Paul places his hope in the cross of Christ. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to rejoice that their names are written in heaven. Like the disciples before us, we are invited to participate in Christ's mission for the salvation of souls. To share in Christ's mission entails sharing in his suffering as well. If, like Paul, we bear the marks of our suffering for Christ, then he will recognize himself in us, when he comes again to judge the living and the dead. Let us rejoice and thank God for the gift of redemption and the opportunity of salvation which he won for us. May we have the strength to persevere until the end, so that we might claim our place in the new Jerusalem, comforted in the loving arms of God. *As a mother Conforth her child, so he will comfort us.*

Al igual que los discípulos que nos precedieron, estamos invitados a participar en la misión de Cristo para la salvación de las almas. Participar en la misión de Cristo implica también compartir su sufrimiento. Si, como Pablo, llevamos las marcas de nuestro sufrimiento por Cristo, él se reconocerá en nosotros cuando venga de nuevo a juzgar a vivos y muertos. Alegrémonos y agradezcamos a Dios por el don de la redención y la oportunidad de salvación que nos concedió. Que tengamos la fuerza para perseverar hasta el final, para que podamos reclamar nuestro lugar en la nueva Jerusalén, confortados en los brazos amorosos de Dios. Como una madre conforta a su hijo, así él nos confortará.

Scripture Readings

First Reading: Thus says the LORD: Rejoice with Jerusalem and be glad because of her, all you who love her; exult, exult with her, all you who were mourning over her! Oh, that you may suck fully of the milk of her comfort, that you may nurse with delight at her abundant breasts! For thus says the LORD: Lo, I will spread prosperity over Jerusalem like a river, and the wealth of the nations like an overflowing torrent. As nurslings, you shall be carried in her arms, and fondled in her lap; as a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you; in Jerusalem you shall find your comfort. When you see this, your heart shall rejoice and your bodies flourish like the grass; the LORD's power shall be known to his servants. ([Isaiah 66:10-14c](#))

Psalm: Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

Second: Brothers and sisters: May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. For neither does circumcision mean anything, nor does uncircumcision, but only a new creation. Peace and mercy be to all who follow this rule and to the Israel of God. From now on, let no one make troubles for me; for I bear the marks of Jesus on my body. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers and sisters. Amen. ([Galatians 6:14-18](#))

Gospel: At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you. Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another. Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.' Whatever town you enter and they do not receive you, go out into the streets and say, 'The dust of your town that clings to our feet, even that we shake off against you.' Yet know this: the kingdom of God is at hand. I tell you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom on that day than for that town." The seventy-two returned rejoicing, and said, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name." Jesus said, "I have observed Satan fall like lightning from the sky. Behold, I have given you the power to 'tread upon serpents' and scorpions and upon the full force of the enemy and nothing will harm you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven." ([Luke 10:1-12, 17-20](#))

Faith Formation Registration

Registration for the 2025-26 school year will be held after all Masses the **weekends of August 23 & 24, August 30 & 31 and the final day to register your student is on Sunday, September 7. No new students will be accepted after September 7th!!!!!!**

Please come by the Parish Hall and get your children registered. Classes are available for ages 5 years through 18 years.

Cost is \$60 per student and \$35 fee for the final year of preparation for 1st Communion and for the final year of preparation for Confirmation.

Classes will begin on Sunday, October 5th. Class times will be 9:15am-10:30am, 11:15am—12:30pm and 1:15pm—2:30pm for grades K—5th. Classes for 6th and 7th grades will be from 3:15-4:30pm. The class for 8th grade, Confirmation final year will be 9:15pm-11:15pm.

Inscripción para la Formación en la Fe

La inscripción para el año escolar 2025-26 se realizará después de todas las misas de los fines **de semana del 23 y 24 de agosto, 30 y 31 de agosto, y el último día para inscribir a su hijo/a es el domingo 7 de septiembre. ¡No se aceptarán nuevos estudiantes después del 7 de septiembre!**
